A presentation script of 100 words or less to be read during the 2018 Georgia Engineering Awards should your nominee be selected. **PLEASE NOTE:** This presentation script may also be used in the program, *Engineering Georgia* magazine, and other media outlets should your nominee be selected and may be edited for length and/or clarity.
- C. Nominee's name and company as it should appear on the award plaque should your nominee be selected.
- D. A letter of nomination and sponsorship from the appropriate engineering society or engineering department head. This should be on society or company letterhead.
- E. A minimum of three letters of endorsement from peers and fellow engineers with specific first-hand knowledge of the nominee's work-related contributions to engineering.
- F. A resume is required.
- G. Photograph in a **jpeg** file format with at least 300 dpi resolution (Color or Black and White) **Note:** A quality photo is required for press and recognition purposes (preferably professional photo).
- H. Submit a flash drive with all required criteria to the following address by **Friday, September 29, 2017:**
