The Lakemont Course at Stone Mountain Golf Club offers a target-oriented layout and exquisite views of Stone Mountain and the surrounding lake. Georgia native John LaFoy designed the Lakemont Course.

The front 9 holes wind around Stone Mountain Lake; six holes have water in play. The back 9 have beautiful holes with rock outcroppings, including 4 holes where water comes into play. LaFoy's penchant for mounding and dramatic bunkering is evident throughout the course. The striking elevation changes offer a unique ambience that appeals to every golfer.
